The BRUT 'summer NON school' is a FREE opportunity for children between the ages of 10-16. They will participate in movement-based creativity experiments - playing, exploring and building.

The school is designed by the artist collective BRUT, Anna Tüdős and Marija Nemčenko, both experienced playworkers. The activities are carried out in participation with LINKES Community Project and Baltic Street Adventure Playground, funded by Creative Scotland.



The two-weeks programme will include lots of play, sports and practical, hands-on workshops designed to boost creativity, collaborative skills, make participants move and think critically about their local environments.

What would young people like their public spaces to offer? How can they create interventions into public space to promote movement and sports? We will attempt to answer these questions by screening short films, going on walks, moving our bodies and engaging in discussions. We will offer arts activities such as mapping, drawing, modelling and sculpting and invited guest workshop leaders will give an insight into urban athleticism.
